THE GOOD AND THE BAD

I really enjoy fishing late season .. Fishing pressure is usually light, parking is never a big issue, and the fishing can be great. There is a draw back this year and it seems to be a lack of water. Several ramps I've heard about are Sumacio, Pensaukee and Kewaunee. Any ramps you find that are difficult this year?

Had the pleasure fishing with my fishing partner Bill Capelle on Sunday (10-7) .. Greeted by a empty parking lot, light westerly winds (well lighter then of late) and a few fish (5 for 6) but ended with a dinged prop.



INTERESTING STUFF FROM TAMMIE PAOLI WDNR

I want to fill you in as we are beginning our fall brown trout electrofishing surveys on the lower Menominee River, between Stephenson Island and the Hattie Street dam, and being right in town, I get a lot of inquiries as to what we are doing and what we are seeing.

We gave it a try on Monday 10/8 and did not net any brown trout. As many of you know, the water levels in the bay (and influencing the Menominee River) are only a few inches above the record low. In addition, we are in a drought and the flow at McAllister USGS gauge is under 900 cfs/cubic feet per second. Last year at this time flows were between 1400-1800 cfs. This made it difficult for us to navigate the river and effectively shock the prime areas that we typically catch browns. .

Of interest, however, were several dozen pink salmon about 13-17 inches long which is a typical size from what I've read about them. Some reach 24 inches but they certainly don't compare to Kings in size. Most pink salmon that we saw today appeared to be spent females, but I've heard several reports of males with their distinct humpback being caught by anglers on the Menominee and Oconto Rivers. Another distinguishing feature is the larger spots on their tail. Tammie Paoli WDNR
